ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

SCHOOL OF COMMERCE

To meet the challenges of emerging scenario in the twenty first century and to optimally exploit the new opportunities in the field of Commerce, the School of Commerce was started in September, 1990. ENVIRONMENTAL ACCOUNTING

Every business has an overriding responsibility to make the fullest possible use of resources. An enterprise is a corporate citizen. Responsibility towards environment has become one of the most crucial areas of social responsibility. Recent years have witnessed rising concern for environmental degradation which is taking place mainly in the form of pollution. Effects of environmental destruction include global warming, climatic change, ozone layer depletion, land degradation and human disease. Environmental destruction occurs when events deplete the earth's natural resources. Its main causes are technological, institutional and socio-economic activities. The developing countries like India are facing the twin problem of protecting the

environment and promoting economic development and a tradeoff between environmental protection and development is required. A careful assessment of benefits and cost of environmental damages is necessary to find the safe limits of environmental degradation and the required level of development. Therefore, the need for environmental accounting has emerged.

Environmental accounting is a form of accounting that analyzes economic and environmental information in order to help businesses make prudent financial decisions. Environmental accounting occurs at both the corporate and national level. To promote optimal business functioning, environmental accountants measure and communicate the economic impact that a company will have on the environment. Some of the costs that these accountants will analyze include those involved in cleaning up and/or remediating a contaminated site, penalties and taxes, environmental fines, waste management costs, and the purchase of technologies designed to facilitate pollution prevention.
