The BOS committee (2021-22) comprised of the HOD, faculty members, Alumni and experts from central universities: Tamilnadu & Kerala, and student member. The M.Sc. E-Learning Technology syllabus was already mailed to the panel and the members provided their suggestions.

Expert Suggestion: Adding MOOC component

Dr.K.P. Suresh, Professor, Central University, Kerala, suggested that more MOOC components preparation methods can be added to the course in total (60/40) adhering to the recommendation of apex bodies of the MHRD. In addition it was pointed out that more external components can be included to explain the methodology for teaching that particular curriculum.

Blended Learning

Prof.P.Sivakumar, Professor of Education, Alagappa University, suggested that more chance should be given for blended learning methodology and on-line courses.

Dr.N.Boobalakrishnan, Assistant Professor, Central University, Tamilnadu, opined that the syllabus is comprehensive and inclusive of all aspects related to the domain.

The suggestion of the experts have been taken into account and the BOS included components related to LMS and Software tools for the final curriculum draft.

Writing Aspects

“According to the Industrial expert Mr.K.Padmanabhan There is a lot of emphasis on writing. He suggested to include writing for linear and nonlinear scenarios, video, games, and writing for animation and this has been incorporated in syllabus.

Architectures and Methods

It was suggested by alumni to include Receptive, Directive, Guided discovery, Exploratory. (E-Learning Instructional Grounds: Behaviourism, Cognitivism and Constructivism.) as well as using architectures and methods to create lessons and courses.

Project Management

It was suggested to include use of PM tools, and work flow, Exposure to agile project by expert and this has been incorporated.


Media

It was suggested by alumni to include more details for E- Content Production and this has been incorporated and Value added, Job Oriented Certificate course.

The syllabus was duly approved in the corresponding SCAA.
