Action Taken Report- 2018-19

1. In View of **Students feedback**, **M.Sc. Microbiology** Programme was introduced during the Academic Year 2018-2019. The course microbiology is essential for the study and understanding of all life on this planet and it also correlates the environment and human system.
2. In view of **Teachers feedback** and also to meet the new educational policy, inclusion of Outcome based Education in curriculum focused on empowering students with domain skills and knowledge on applications was insisted in all Boards of Studies. 21st century skills such as design thinking, cross-cultural communication, cognitive load management, etc., are given due importance.
3. Based on the **Alumni feedback**, it was decided to strengthen the Alumni Association. IQAC insisted the Bharathiar University Alumni Association (BUAA) to conduct Annual meet continuously and for registering the Association. Subsequently Alumni meetings were held annually.
4. Based on the **Employers feedback** on Entrepreneurship and based on the initiative of Ministry of Education and Institution Innovation Cell, a conducive ecosystem for entrepreneurship should be established in the University campus. Bharathiar University - Institution Innovation Cell (BU-IIC) was established in 2018 and started conducting events as per the directions of IIC, Delhi.
5. Based on the feedback from **Alumni, Subject expert and Industrial Expert** **M.Sc. Information Technology** has revised the syllabus 54%, **M.Sc. Industrial Biotechnology** has revised with 64%, **M.A. Sociology** has revised with 71%. This revision caters the students with latest developments and upgrades the technological aspects pertaining to the field.
6. The **girl students** expressed the lack of residential facilities (hostel). The already available hostel facilities could accommodate only 265 students. Based on the request

and requirement, construction of new Ladies hostel was proposed and the construction was completed in 2018 at a cost of Rs. 2.5 crore. The financial assistance from RUSA is appreciated at this juncture. This new hostel facility could accommodate around 400 girls
